



Brontë

Following the playreading of Brontë by Polly Teale - an imaginative and moving dramatization of the story of the three Brontë sisters - it was selected as the production for autumn next year. Plans are currently being put together for the tour of towns and villages in west Devon and east Cornwall. Auditions will be announced in a later Newsletter.
